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ProfilPASS – aims

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What is the ProfilPASS?


- Instruments that helps you to identify your present qualifications, skills, and competences
- Lifelong instrument

Aims:


- Name and grade strengths
→ result: **personal profile** - collection of all qualifications, skills, and competences you have acquired
- This profile should help you
 - ... with your personal or professional reorientation or development
 - ... to complete application documents
 - ... to set your personal and professional goals
- Assessment method: declarative method

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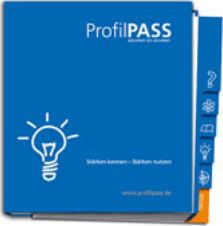


ProfilPASS – methods

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How does the ProfilPASS work?

- ProfilPASS-system = folder + professional consulting
- Folder contains...
 1. My life – an overview
 2. My areas of activity
 - Hobbies and interests
 - Household and family
 - School
 - Job training
 - Military service, community service, voluntary (social, ecological, ...) year
 - Work life, internships, jobs
 - Political and social commitment / volunteering
 - Unusual living conditions
 3. My competences – a balance
 4. My goals and next steps

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ProfilPASS – competences

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- Distinction between **skills** and **competences**

“**Skills** require expertise and know-how that enable a person to successfully fulfill a certain task. There are professional and generic skills.”


“**Competences** are skills which can also be used in other situations or contexts and can be transferred to other tasks and which can be explained or shown to other people. Therefore, it is important that the person currently possesses this competence.”

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– benefits


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- Due to intense and systematic analysis of your life you can
 - ... screen areas of life step by step
 - ... find out special interests and strengths
 - ... set goals
 - ... plan next steps
 - ... proof missing qualifications

→ self-reflection, **no certificate**

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What is the europass?

- Present qualifications, skills, and competences in a comprehensible form

→ **Transparency, mobility, and comparability**



Aims

- Opens the door to learning and work in Europe across all areas including
 - higher education study
 - training
 - job search
 - within the scope of salaried employment or freelance work
- Assessment method: portfolio method

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How does the europass work?


Standardized europass documents which are issued in a uniform format right across Europe

- europass Curriculum Vitae
- europass Language Passport
- europass Certificate Supplements
- europass Mobility
- europass Diploma Supplement



→ documents record all qualifications acquired during the course of lifetime

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europass mobility


- Provides evidence of periods of learning spent in other European countries in the form of
 - Practical placement
 - As part of a course of vocational education and training
 - Higher education study

→ document records these learning experiences (knowledge and competences)
→ useful for job applications


- Document cannot be filled in by applicants themselves

 - *Language* skills and competences
 - *Computer* skills and competences
 - *Organizational* skills and competences
 - *Social* skills and competences
 - *Other* skills and competences

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europass – benefit


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- Potential of standardized europass documents:
 - ... linked to the EQF and the ECVET
 - ... ECTS is already integrated into the europass Mobility and the europass Diploma Supplement

→ Useful documents for job applications (benefits to applicants and employers)
